

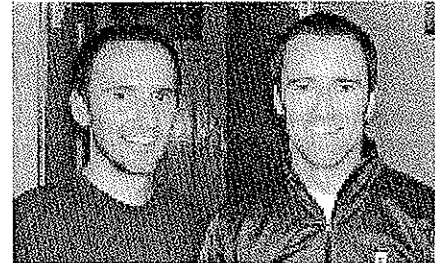

A Volunteer In Community Radio

When I was a member of the Army, I was warned never to volunteer for anything because you could end up doing something other than what you thought was a good deed. As this is not the Army, I guessed my input would be viewed somewhat more for the good of 96.5 Inner FM, rather than being placed in the firing line to die a heroic death.

Community Radio is a brilliant concept. Broadcast radio in all its forms, presented by an array of people who volunteer their time to present entertainment. The trick, I believe, is to have a structured system that enables the Station to run at a professional level whilst keeping the community spirit. With 102 programs per week and 60 or so presenters, 96.5 Inner FM has more than its share of community spirit. Finances, clerical, production and programming all have to be addressed by the Committee of Management on a regular basis.

We are a business, and to stay 'on the air' volunteers fill these positions to keep the Station operating. Having a background in radio is not a prerequisite for finding a position within the Station. Most of the volunteers, past and present, had never seen the inside of a studio before they walked through the door to offer their services. But through training, advice, and a little confidence, they were able to find their niche. Presenting a program, doing voice-overs, production, co-ordinating, even answering the telephone correctly are skills that ultimately make the running of Inner FM a professional entity. We like to think of our group of people as a family - and in the main it is. One helps another in all aspects of the day-to-day running of a setup such as ours however menial it may seem.
