VAFA FOOTY UPDATE

The 2013 VAFA Premier section home and away season is now complete and the four clubs in contention for the Premiership have been decided: Old Xaverians, St. Bedes Mentone Tigers, Old Scotch and Uni. Blacks.

No real surprise to see perennial premierhip contenders, Old Xaverians once again figure prominently, finishing the season as Minor Premiers after a dominant season. However, like runners-up St. Bedes Mentone Tigers, the Xavs were slow starters allowing the two newly promoted clubs, Uni. Blacks and Beaumaris make the early running with some good wins against quality sides. Whilst the Blacks were able to maintain their form throughout the season, Beaumaris found the going tough but staged something of a late season revival to cement their place in Premier section in 2014.

The same could not be said, however, for Old Carey and University Blues who finished the season in the last two places and have been relegated to Premier B in 2014. The Blues have been a prominent Premier section club for many years, winning a Premiership in 2004 under long-time coach and Inner FM Special Comments guru, John Kanis, but have struggled in recent years whilst Old Carey spent just two seasons in the top section.

Both clubs will undoubtedly re-group in Premier B next season and will make their way back to the top grade in seasons to come. The Inner FM broadcast team will particularly miss calling games from the magnificent Carey Grammar sports complex in Bulleen Road, not only for the wonderful broadcast position it provides but also the tremendous hospitality extended by the Old Carey club; their hard working President, Paul Newton and all the club

volunteer who went out of their way to make the Inner FM broadcast team welcome. To them we say "Thanks!"

Semi Finals are this coming weekend at Sportscover Arena, Elsternwick with Old Xaverians taking on St. Bedes in the 2nd Semi on Saturday with the winner advancing to the Grand Final on the 21st and the loser taking on the winner of Sunday's 1st Semi between Old Scotch and Uni. Blacks in next week's Preliminary Final.

Meanwhile, the Finals series continue in the other Sections. Old Brighton comprehensively defeated Premier B Minor Premiers, Old Trinity, on Saturday, not only booking a spot in the Grand Final on Sunday week but also securing promotion to the Premier section next season. Old Trinity will now play Old Melburnians in this weekend's Preliminary Final for the right to meet Old Brighton in the Grand Final and to join the "Tonners" in Premier section in 2014. The Premier B Grand Final will be broadcast on Inner FM on Sunday week, 15th September, from 2:00 p.m.

As in 2012, the Saturday morning "VAFA Footy Show" will be broadcast direct from Sportscover Arena this Saturday and the following two from 9.

It's been another memorable season of VAFA Football on Inner FM, lead and co-ordinated, as always by our President, Ken Petrucco with the best team of callers on radio lead by Michael Crooks, Andrew Leonard and Simon Petch; Special Comments by John Kanis and Ken and great technical and logistical backup by Tim Armastong and Glen Dragomire. Together and individually, they are one hell of a team!
